



WOOL GATHERING
Marian's
'Easy Crochet Poppy Pattern'

Make a loop:

**Make a chain of 4 single crochet stitches
then join the chain to make a loop with a single slip stitch**

**Crochet 11½ trebles into this ring
Join onto the top of the first chain with a slip stitch**

**Do 1 chain to start the new row
now do 2 x ½ trebles into the spaces to create your second row
Once half way round do 2 slip stitches into the top of the
previous row to pull in the waist of the poppy**

**Crochet 1 chain to start the new row
Continue round till you get back to your starting point,
finish with 2 slip stitches.**

This will have created 2 indentations on each side of the flower.

**This time crochet 2 chains and go round again, this time
alternate 2 x ½ trebles with 1x1/2 trebles into each hole or space.**

**As above crochet 2 slip stitches to the 2 on the previous row
and continue round.**

**When you have completed 3 full rounds finish by
cutting the wool & pulling through to knot the end.**
